Pre-op instructions to remember for surgery.

You should stop taking all anti-inflammatories 7 days and anti-coagulants 5 days prior to surgery.

You are to have nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before your surgery.

Remember to bring your films with you to the hospital on the day of surgery. (Myelogram, CT scan, MRI, X-ray).
